

The temperatures are falling and we are sure each of you is getting ready to head south. We are hoping you will be <u>very</u> delighted when you see our beautiful community – groomed, cleaned, refreshed and well-maintained. Your manager, Steve Pigman, and his crew and vendors have been focused on detail and disciplined on completing all the summer projects.

From your HOA board cont...

The Board continues to review the over-all operation of the community. Here are some points of interest:

New website: www.CypressWoodsRV.net is our newly designed and easily accessible website. Make sure you check this out, as it will keep you informed of so many resort activities and news.

Owner's lots for sale or rent: If you have a lot for sale/rent, simply email Pat Zollo with your information (patzollo@yahoo.com). There will be 3 ways that we will be getting this info into the hands of any inquiry:

- 1. It will be posted on our website.
- 2. The Gate Greeters will be handing them out to visitors who inquire.
- 3. If an inquiry is called into the office, our receptionist will give them our website Information and they can review this list.

Maintenance: Our Town Center kitchen is newly repainted and new slats installed in fencing behind section B. The Welcome Center has been pressure-washed and looks fresh and new. Three new washers are now installed in the Welcome Center.

Phone System: The installation is complete with our new Comcast phone system – completely separate from the Developer's. This conversion has saved us \$3700 annually.

Luckett Road lighting: Lee County advises us that we will need a community petition signed by the residents in order for any additional Luckett Road lighting to be installed.

We are looking for some volunteers to head up this campaign. We do have the contact names and numbers for Lee County. Simply email/call Steve Pigman or a Board member, if you would be able to assist us with this project.

Staffing: Annual performance evaluations have been given to each staff member. Along with this, any pay increases will go into effect Jan. 1, 2016. We are currently rewriting each position's job description and will be establishing a pay range for that position. This will create a fair and balanced performance evaluation system.

Section E: The bank that foreclosed on the property has hired a real estate agent to sell the land. It is listed for \$3.7 million and is being advertised. We have no other news than this.

Delinquencies: As of 9/30/15, there are 18 owners who are 30 days or more delinquent on their dues and/or special assessment. This totals \$20,130. All have been sent late notices and letters. Four of these lots are being turned over to our attorney for the beginning of legal action.

Financial Stability: All bills are paid and current. We are operating solidly in the BLACK. Our financial future is looking bright. All financials are published on First Services website for your viewing. If, however, you need help in comprehending, simply contact our manager, Steve Pigman, and he will answer your questions.

Did you know? For every lot that is sold in the resort, the HOA collects \$300 in transfer/recording fees? In 2015, to date the total collected is \$6300.



It's important to us that each owner "stays in the know!" We hope this information helps you understand your HOA and management commitment to serving you as best we can!

Monthly Driveway Sales - In an effort to keep appearances up in the park, the Board has instituted a policy that items are not to be placed on or around the trash compactor...something that we all most likely have done. Many owners expressed concerns about not having a way to discard usable items that they no longer want or need.

We would like to try a "Driveway Sale" pilot program starting on October 31st and continuing on the last Saturday of each month.

Owners/Occupants of the lot can place items out for sale or free, depending on your preference.

The driveway sale will run from 9 AM - 12 PM. If you have free items, you may leave them at the end of your driveway until dark; then they must be removed. At the end of the day, if no one wants the items, you can save them for the next month or dispose of them. This way you have an opportunity to get rid of functioning items, and we don't have the compactor area cluttered up.

Security Question

Does Cypress Woods RV Resort Homeowners Association provide security to the Community?

Only to a small extent in that we have access control gates at the main entrance and an emergency access gate in the back of the community. The only other "security" services we provide are locks on the common buildings and an alarm in the offices' section of the Welcome Center. For access into the community through the access gates, one must have a white swipe card, a car tag or a code to open such gates. For entry into the Town Center during door lock times, one must have a white swipe card. These items can only be obtained through the management office. At times, we do have gate greeters; however, these are not security personnel. So when you are not around, whether for an hour, a day or months, lock up your items because the association is not responsible for your security, nor do we claim in any way to provide security to the resort.
