## YOUR HOA NEWS --- Keeping you in the know!

From your HOA Board...

During the recent HOA meeting, your Board approved the 2017 operating budget. Here is a quick overview of both planned expenses and income by category:

**Administrative Expenses:** Increase of 18% over 2016. Due to the active lawsuits with the Developer and a past employee, we increased our legal fee account significantly.

**Property Insurance:** No increase planned – provider is holding costs.

**Utilities:** Increase of 11% over 2016: Two items reflect the major part of this expense increase: Water, sewer and our telephone system.

**Contracts:** Increase of 6% over 2016. Contributing items are:

- 4% increase in cable TV
- 5% increase Newell's lawn care – they held prices for 3 years and a new 2 year contract was signed – we are increasing the planting of perennials over annuals to maintain consistent color
- NO INCREASE with First Service Residential – our property management company. Contract expires February of 2017 but if we re-new, no increase.
- 6% wage increase –this is performance based ranging from 0- 11% and in some positions, a one time market adjustment - this includes a 22% burden rate of fringe benefits.

**Repairs & Maintenance:** Increase of 4% over 2016: Planned projects for 2017 are:

- Consider replacing Luckett Road fencing
- \$7700 Welcome Center window replacement
- \$4500 Town Center pool deck paver cleaning and sealing
- \$9000 Town Center chairs and Omni Room tables & chairs
- \$14,000 new pool furniture possibly for both pools
- Tennis court resurfacing
- Insurance company recommended property appraisal

**Reserves:** Increase of funding by 30% to accommodate planned capital improvements, including painting of the Town Center, Welcome Center and improved signage.

**Income:** Increase of 8% over 2016: For over 5 years we have not increased our monthly assessments. Through that, we were still able to replace, refurbish and renew broken down equipment, fixtures, landscaping and roads. Beginning January 2017, our monthly lot assessments will increase a modest \$12.50 – generating over \$56,000 annually in increase revenue. This increase will help fund the planned expenses noted previously.
